WHAT ARE FIREWISE COMMUNITIES?

FIREWISE USA is a voluntary recognition program through the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA). In a FIREWISE community, residents come together for community-wide education and action, including home hardening and defensible space.

FIREWISE communities can:

- Strengthen community bonds and educate residents
- Create fire resilient communities
- Enable access to insurance discounts

Steps to becoming FIREWISE:

- Gather 3-5 neighbors to work on the FIREWISE app.
- Request a Community Wildfire Risk Assessment
- Use the assessment to create a 3-Year-Action-Plan
- Every year work to reduce your wildfire risk!
